Obituary:

William A. Szymanski, age 94, of Kenosha, died on Monday, November 3, 2014, at St. Joseph's Home and Rehab Center.

A lifelong resident of Kenosha, he was born on May 29, 1920, and was the son of the late Peter and Helen (Szarbajka) Szymanski.

Bill honorably served in the U.S. Army during World War II in the Philippines, from December 9, 1941 until February 1, 1946. He proudly achieved the rank of Platoon Sergeant and received numerous commendations, including the American Defense Medal, American Theater, Asiatic-Pacific Theater Ribbon with one bronze star, Philippine Liberation Ribbon with one bronze star, the WWII Medal and Good Conduct Medal.

On August 14, 1948, he was united in marriage to Mary Dorothy White in Michigan. Sadly after 51 years of marriage, she preceded him in death on March 5, 2000.

For over 42 years, Bill was employed with AMC/Chrysler Corp., retiring in 1982 from their final repair department.

He was a member of St. Peter Catholic Church, P.L.A.V. James Smelcer Post #34, U.A.W. Local #72 Retirees and the Civilian Conservation Corps.

Bill enjoyed spending time fishing and golfing.

He is survived by his three daughters, Catherine A. (Frank) Gabron, Gail (Albert) Aiello and Judy (Rick) Bruns; six grandchildren; two great grandchildren and many loving nieces and nephews.
